GOUDJI

was born in Georgia in 1941 and studied at the academy of the arts in Tbilisi.

After his artistic work in Moscow, a new phase in his artistic career began with the acceptance of French citizenship in 1978 and the move to Paris.

The important silver sculptor Goudji made works for the Paris Salon International, for the Musée des arts décoratifs de Paris, for the treasury of the Cathédrale Notre-Dame de Paris and for the liturgical collection of Pope John Paul II.

In addition to numerous other honors, he was named Chevalier des "Ordre de la Légion d'honneur" by President Nicolas Sarkozy in 2009 for his life's work.
